

Frogs vs. Salamanders Venn Diagram

Assembly instructions:

Cut out along solid lines. Fold along the center fold. Cut on the dotted lines to create three flaps. On the inside, have students draw a line to divide the three sections. (To fit on the lapbook, this fold-it will need to be folded again. Just fold the frog and salamander tabs inward.)

Teacher Directions: Have students list the things that frogs and salamanders have in common (amphibians, vertebrates, cold-blooded, need water). Then, list the ways frogs and salamanders are different.
